 - 2.1.2. Version of Record ("VoR"): the version of the Contribution that is formally published in the Journal. The VoR includes any corrected or enhanced VoR.
- 2.2. The term "Supplementary Material" ("SM") means any additional written or illustrative materials submitted or uploaded to the Journal by the Authors for publication in connection with the Contribution.
